Dear Student,

It is a requirement that all matriculated students have health insurance coverage.

For the Fall 2013 semester, students who wish to waive or enroll in the health insurance plan must access The Cooper Union Accident and Sickness plan on-line at www.cirstudenthealth.com/cooper using their Cooper Union ID number. Beginning in the Fall 2013 semester, **International and Exchange students will NOT be permitted to waive their health insurance and are required to enroll in the Cooper Union health insurance plan.**

Please be advised that the insurance you provide must be currently active and will be subject to verification by the insurance company. If you do not provide proof of insurance by August 16, 2013, you will not be allowed to waive your insurance and must pay for the Fall semester portion. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
