Connecticut State University chancellor David Carter has announced that he will retire March 1.

Michael C. McFarland, president of the College of the Holy Cross (Worcester, MA), is stepping down. McFarland plans to stay on until a successor is found, and then take a one-year sabbatical.

Lane Glenn, currently the college's vice president of academic affairs, has been selected as the next president of Northern Essex Community College (Haverhill, MA).

Cooper Union (New York, NY) has chosen Jamshed Bharucha, the provost and senior vice president of Tufts University (Medford, MA), to be its next president.

Robert Smith III, senior vice president of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, today was appointed head of Texas A&M University at Galveston by the university's governing board.

Former deputy premier Shirley McClellan has been appointed as the next chancellor at the University of Lethbridge (Alberta, Canada).
