**Drugs** Students should be aware that, in addition to Cooper Union sanctions, they may be subject to criminal prosecution under federal and state laws which specify severe penalties, including fines and imprisonment for drug-related criminal offenses. The chart below provides information concerning Federal law. New York State law on this issue is extensive; students who would like a copy of the relevant state laws may request one at the Office of Student Services or download one from FindLaw.com.

<sup>\*</sup>The minimum sentence for a violation after two or more prior convictions for a felony drug offense have become final is a mandatory term of life imprisonment without release and a fine up to \$8 million if an individual and \$20 million if other than an individual.

## Federal Penalties and Sanctions for Illegal Possession of a Controlled Substance

### 21 U.S.C. 844(a)

First conviction: Up to one year imprisonment and fined at least \$1,000 but not more than \$100,000, or both.

After one prior drug conviction: At least 15 days in prison, not to exceed 2 years and fined at least \$2,500 but not more than \$250,000, or both. After 2 or more prior drug convictions: at least 90 days in prison, not to exceed three years and fined at least \$5000, but not more than \$250,000, or both

Special sentencing provisions for possession of crack cocaine: Mandatory at least five years in prison, not to exceed 20 years and fined up to \$250,000 or both, if:

- (a) first conviction and the amount of crack possessed exceeds 5 grams.
- (b) second crack conviction and the amount of crack possessed exceeds 3 grams.
- (c) third or subsequent crack conviction and the amount of crack possessed exceeds one gram.

## 21 U.S.C. 853(a) (2) and 881(a) (7)

Forfeiture of personal and real property used to possess or to facilitate possession of a controlled substance if that offense is punishable by more than one year imprisonment.

### 21 U.S.C. 881(a)(4)

Forfeiture of vehicles, boats, aircraft or any other conveyance used to transport or conceal a controlled substance.

#### 21 U.S.C. 844a

Civil fine up to \$10,000.

#### 21 U.S.C. 862

Denial of Federal benefits, such as student loans, grants, contracts, and professional and commercial licenses, up to one year for first offense, up to five years for second and subsequent offenses.

#### 8 U.S.C. 922(q)

Ineligible to receive, purchase or transport a firearm.

Revocation of certain Federal licenses and benefits, e.g. pilot licenses, public housing tenancy, etc. are vested within the authorities of individual Federal agencies.
