









הטַּהוּלָה דְּסֻקָּה תְּסִוִּידָרֶת



a **sukkah** is a rustic tabernacle built within specific parameters set by jewish law where families eat, sleep, and gather for autumn's harvest during the festival of sukkot.

teams are invited to propose a novel sukkah design that uses biophilic materials and can be built for \$3,000 in three days, with radically experimental, bio-based building solutions encouraged. interdisciplinary, interfaith teams are welcome. a curators' panel will select four teams for a fully funded one week retreat to build, test, learn from, and sleep in their sukkot at urban adamah in berkeley, ca in october 2024.
