APPLICATION DEADLINES	Fall & Spring semester: June 1st
APPLICATION PROCESS	1. Students fill out the online form (link sent after the nomination) 2. Send the following documents to international@beauxartsparis.fr - A nomination letter/e-mail from the home school; - An art portfolio (20/25 pages maximum, 20 MO max); - A letter of motivation of the applicant presenting a short description of his/her current artistic work, explains why he/she wants to study at Beaux-Arts de Paris and specify the studio that he/she wishes to join; - A resume; - A copy of the passport; - A photo (jpeg - ID format suitable for a student card)
N.B.	<u>Except for the photo</u> , all documents should be sent in PDF format and under a suitable title specifying the name and type of document (eg: NAME_portfolio)
ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS	Prospective exchange students: - must have an active contemporary art practice reflected in their portfolio (painting, sculpture/installation, photo, video...) and carry it throughout the exchange (no research project only exchange) - have validated at least 2 years of art studies at the time of their exchange - are not PhD students (we only accept bachelor and master students) - are not design/graphic design/fashion students
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT	No minimum, but it is advised to have some notions of French - we recommend B1. NB: Theoretical courses are taught in French.
SELECTION PROCESS	After receiving the applications, Beaux-Arts de Paris organizes a selection committee - the applicants will receive an e-mail confirming their acceptance to the school 3 weeks after the application deadline.

LEARNING AGREEMENT	Exchange students must take 4 course units during the semester spent at Beaux-Arts de Paris for a total of 30 ECTS (credits):

	- Studio - Artistic Practice Department: 16 ECTS - Technical Skills: 6 ECTS - Elective Course*: 6 ECTS - French Language Course**: 2 ECTS <i>*May be chosen from technical or theory courses.</i> <i>**Instead of the French language course, French-speaking students can take another theory or technical course.</i>
GRADING SYSTEM & TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS	The Beaux-Arts de Paris study programme follows a curriculum based on the European Credit Transfer System (E.C.T.S.). Pass or Fail: Beaux-Arts de Paris does not provide grades or marks, only a pass or fail indication, with the number of ECTS associated with the course.
FRENCH LESSONS	French as a Foreign Language lessons (3 hours per week) are mandatory for the non-French-speaking students during their whole exchange semester.
