

INDEPENDENT STUDY WORK PROPOSAL

This form must be completed and returned to the Office of Academic Advising by the first Thursday of the semester.

School of Art independent study is an alternative to classroom study and may be taken only with a member of the resident faculty (defined as full-time or proportional-time faculty members or adjunct faculty members on three-year appointments). The major consideration in approving proposals for independent study is the educational value of the study project within the structure of the degree requirements.

Only juniors and seniors in good academic standing are eligible for independent study. There is a limit of one School of Art independent study per semester. Independent study may be planned for one, two, or three credits.

Each credit of independent study represents a minimum of three hours of work during each week of a 15-week semester.
