ACEC New York Awards Scholarships to 28 New York Engineering Students

NEW YORK, May 22, 2023 — Twenty-eight engineering students attending colleges and universities in New York State have received \$101,500 collectively in scholarships from member firms and regions of the American Council of Engineering Companies of New York (ACEC New York). Individual awards range from \$1,500 to \$10,000 and are given based on the students' cumulative grade-point average, college activities, work experience and essays. For the third year, ACEC New York pledged \$3,000 to support National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE) scholarship students. Two students have each been awarded \$1,500 scholarships. This is in line with our organization and industry's Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging priorities and efforts. Our generous members help ease the financial burden of higher education, allowing students to enjoy their exploration of engineering and make connections that lead to mentoring, internships, and employment opportunities.

Since the program's launch in 2002, ACEC New York has awarded over 400 scholarships and other donations totaling more than 1.2 million dollars. The scholarship program was implemented to support up-and-coming engineers, thereby guaranteeing a strong future for the profession in New York State. We congratulate the Scholarship Committee for another successful year and sincerely thank the ACEC New York scholarship donors for their generosity.

Four of this year's winners were also alumni of the ACE Mentor program, which pairs high school students with mentoring teams composed of industry professionals (many of whom work for member firms) to introduce them to careers in the design and construction industry.
