Literature

Below are possible course sequences that students may to fulfill the requirements of HSS minor in Literature:

The Classics

- 9 credits in Greek, Roman, or in non-Western classical literature (e.g., Greek Tragedy; Lucretius; Eros in Antiquity; Greek Mythology; Homer and the Tragic Vision; The Age of Augustus; Lucretius; East of the Euphrates: Philosophy in the Eastern Hemisphere);
- 3 credits in a post-classical literature through the Renaissance (e.g., Milton; Shakespeare).

The Moderns

- 6 credits in a prose category (e.g., The Novel: Joyce's *Ulysses*; The Fairy Tale; Race and Gender in Literature; Issues in Contemporary Fiction; Baldwin; Irish Modernism [the last two are HSS4, but could be taken as an elective]);
- 6 credits in a poetry category (e.g., Presence of Poetry; Is Painting like Poetry?; Native America); At least 3 credits of the above 12 must be in a non-Western category (e.g., Black Literature in a World Perspective; Native America; The Fairy Tale; Issues in Contemporary Fiction).

Theater and Cinema Studies

- 6 credits in theater studies (e.g., Greek Tragedy; Aristophanes; Opera; Modern Drama [HSS4, but could be taken as an elective]);
- 6 credits in cinema studies (e.g., History of Cinema: 1895-1945; History of Cinema: 1945 to the present; Studies in Cinema). At least 3 of the above 12 credits must be in a theater practicum course (e.g., Playwriting and Theater Practicum; Theater Collaborative).
