SPEAKER **LIANA FINCK**, ART'09

Ms. Finck will discuss her experience as a Fulbright Fellow in Brussels, Belgium. She immersed herself in Belgian comic culture and created a comic about the nightmares of Georges Remi, who wrote the comic book series *The Adventures of Tintin*.

Ms. Finck will talk about applying for a Fulbright Grant, her experience in Belgium, and what she learned about comic culture in Belgium. Ms. Finck will discuss the differences and similarities between American and European comics. She will also describe what it was like to transition from fine arts to comics and how Fulbright helped her to launch her career as a comics artist. Ms. Finck will present pictures of her work and her time in Belgium.

Gwen Hyman, Director of the Center for Writing & Language Arts and The Cooper Union's Fulbright Program Adviser, will join Ms. Finck to provide information and field questions about applying for a Fulbright Grant.
